Exploding the Myth of the Lone Ranger Researcher

Qualitative researchers are increasingly called upon to participate in or even lead complex research teams. Until recently, however, most literature related to the practice of qualitative research framed the endeavor as if it were conducted primarily by individuals working alone. Consequently, few researchers know how to approach qualitative research from a team perspective. This webinar aims to explode the myth of the Lone Ranger Researcher with an up-to-date picture of the state of qualitative research and teams. I will discuss two key areas where qualitative researchers can bring excellent value to the functioning of complex teams. The first area is research design and project organization where qualitative researchers should be important contributors to team formation and the establishment of preliminary and ongoing documentation of team activity, including the development of a project management system using a digital toolkit approach. The second area is the documentation of methods through writing “in-process, ideal, and methodological literature”. This webinar draws heavily on the insights in my recent book: *Qualitative Research and Teams* (2018, Oxford University Press).
